### Sleep through your dental appointments with IV Sedation

Once you've experienced IV Sedation Dentistry, you'll never be afraid to go to the dentist again! You'll be relaxed and unaware of your treatment, and will wake up refreshed, with little or no memory of what happened during your appointment. It's totally safe, and because you are completely relaxed and comfortable, we can do dental treatments that usually require six or eight visits in just one appointment. We can replace crowns or dentures, restore sore gums to good health, whiten yellow or stained teeth, fix a chipped tooth ... and more.



### Why do we offer Sedation Dentistry?

Fear is the single biggest barrier to the delivery of quality dental care. For the patients who avoid dental appointments, sedation offers a way to get dental treatment done in a non-threatening manner. Other patients who may benefit from sedation include those who need surgical procedures or want a lot of work done at one time – sedation helps people with very busy schedules get the dental care they need, often in a single visit.

### How IV Sedation works.

When you sit down in the dental chair, we'll attach monitors to measure your breathing, blood pressure, heart rate and EKG. Then a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA) will start your IV, allowing medications for relaxation to enter your body. They work rapidly to make you feel deeply relaxed, a state that will be maintained and monitored throughout your treatment.

A major benefit of the most commonly used sedation drugs is amnesia – you will have little or no memory of your dental treatment! Another benefit of these drugs is the patient's relatively quick recovery time. Most patients relax and enjoy a light meal that evening, following their treatment.

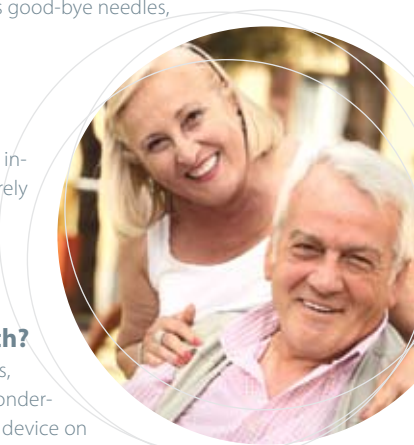
